Junior Activity Program Guidelines:

- Junior activities must be special events for just the junior.
- Activities should be enjoyable for the junior members but also educate them in faith, volunteerism, and patriotism.
- Activity must be connected to and promote NCSF as the sponsor.
- Funds received as a subsidy for a junior activity are to be used, first to recoup any expense connected to the event and then held in the court treasury earmarked solely for future junior activities.
- At least one junior activity should include service to others. Putting faith into action by helping parish or community demonstrates our Love, Benevolence, and Charity.
- Courts can sponsor 5 activities or projects annually for junior members (ages 15 and under). At least 5 junior members must be present at each event to qualify for subsidy.
- One guest event will be subsidized each year. Every junior member who is participating in the activity can invite up to 5 guests.
- The junior members and guests are asked to sign themselves in on the back of this form.
- The activity supervisor/junior director is asked to add the roster numbers for each member.

Reimbursement:

- Junior Court Activity will be subsidized at \$3 for each of the junior members who participated in the activity or project.
- The subsidy given for the invited guests (ages 0-15) will be \$2 per guest at ONE event yearly.
- The activity supervisor/junior director will receive a \$10 stipend for each activity/project.
